Directions To Springfield Country Club 400 West Sproul Road * Springfield, PA * 19064

From Center City Philadelphia:

95 South to 476 North to Exit 3 (Swarthmore/Media). Turn right off exit on Baltimore Pike (Route 1). Proceed on Route 1 for approximately half a mile to Route 320 (West Sproul Road). Turn Left on Route 320. Springfield Country Club is located half a mile on the left.

I-76 West to 476 South to Exit 5 (Springfield/Lima). Turn Left off exit. Follow signs for 320 (West Sproul Road). Turn right on Route 320 (West Sproul Road). Springfield Country Club is located three quarters of a mile on the right.

From Pennsylvania Turnpike, Bucks County, Montgomery County:

Exit 20-Mid County off
Pennsylvania Turnpike to 476
South towards Chester to Exit 5
(Springfield/Lima). Turn left off
exit onto Route 1 North. Stay in
right lane, follow signs for route
320 (West Sproul Road). Turn
Right on Route 320 (West
Sproul Road). Springfield
Country Club is located three
quarters of a mile on the right.

From Delaware:

I-95 North to exit 7 marked I-476 North (Blue Route). From the Blue Route to Exit 3 Springfield- Media. Turn right off exit onto Baltimore Pike (Route 1). Proceed on Route 1 for approximately half a mile to Route 320 (West Sproul Road). Turn Left on Route 320. Springfield Country Club is located half a mile on the left.

From New York/ North Jersey:

Take New Jersey Turnpike to Exit 6/Pennsylvania Turnpike. Follow Turnpike to Exit 20 Mid County Exit. Follow sign for 476/ Chester (Blue Route) to Exit 5 (Springfield/Lima). Turn left off exit onto Route 1 North. Stay in right lane, follow signs for route 320 (West Sproul Road). Turn Right on Route 320 (West Sproul Road). Springfield Country Club is located three quarters of a mile on the right.



As suggested by a club member, we now have an official **DVWGS Pond Help Line!** Bill Fogel has volunteered to be on-hand for any questions that members might have about fish and pond health. You can contact Bill at his home phone 610-687-3105. Bill has also volunteered to submit articles to our newsletter and web site regarding our ponds and fish for the newsletter at various times during the year. **Thank You Bill!** Other club questions will still be answered by Vic Barsky at 215-840-0811

The big thing to do for your fish over the winter is to do partial water changes at about once a month. This CAN be done. When we get a nice day in the 40's get out the sump pump and take water from the bottom of your pond, about 10%. Replace with water and declor. This will make your fish less stressed over winter and in the spring. In the meantime keep this recipe handy for this summer, it makes very happy fish.

DR. WAYNES KOI KUBE RECIPE

8 oz. frozen chopped kale, or chopped collard greens

3/4 Cup frozen peas

4 oz. smelt, white fish, or I use shrimp

1 oz. red pepper

1 med. zucchini

1 or 2 grated carrots

1 Tbs. wheat germ, plus 1 tbs. brewers yeast

2 400 IU Vitamin E caps

2 Vitamin C caps (crushed to powder)

4 packets Knox gelatin

Puree in food processor all but gelatin, and Vitamins. Then add the puree to the gelatin and water, then the Vitamins. (You will have to add water to the puree to get it to mix in the food processor, not too much.)

Spread puree on nonstick cookie sheets, put in freezer for about half hour remove and score puree in 4 in. squares, return to freezer overnight. Remove break apart and store in plastic bag with wax paper between layers. ENJOY!!


